GREEN CLUB ACTIVITIES JUNE, 2022 - MAY, 2023




3) An awareness programme on Environmental Pollution was organised by Green Club, VCFW on 9th December, 2022 at 11 a.m in the New Building Auditorium.

Title of the talk: Sundarban saves Kolkata and Kolkata worsens Suundarban: An air quality perspective.


