The seminar proved to be an effective platform for scientists and researchers to showcase their research articles on



modern chemistry and their application. The key-note address was delivered by Prof. Ashutosh Ghosh, honourable former Vice Chancellor, University of Calcutta. Eminent scientists from different research institutes and universities across India delivered lectures on recent developments in the field of chemical research. Participants from colleges and universities presented their research papers. Special award was given to two best oral poster presentations. The seminar was attended by over 100 participants.

Vidyasagar College for Women has a very active Placement Cell that provides job assistance to outgoing third year students every year. The cell tries to maintain connection with various companies that have shown interest to organize placement drives for our students. Campus interviews are held where meritorious students are selected for jobs. Three I.T. companies (T.C.S., Technoscope & Noboundstech) visited the campus and recruited our students after rigorous rounds of written tests and interview.

The committee members visited 'Naba Jiban', home for destitute children on April 20 to distribute food packets and stationeries.






NSS Special Camp
