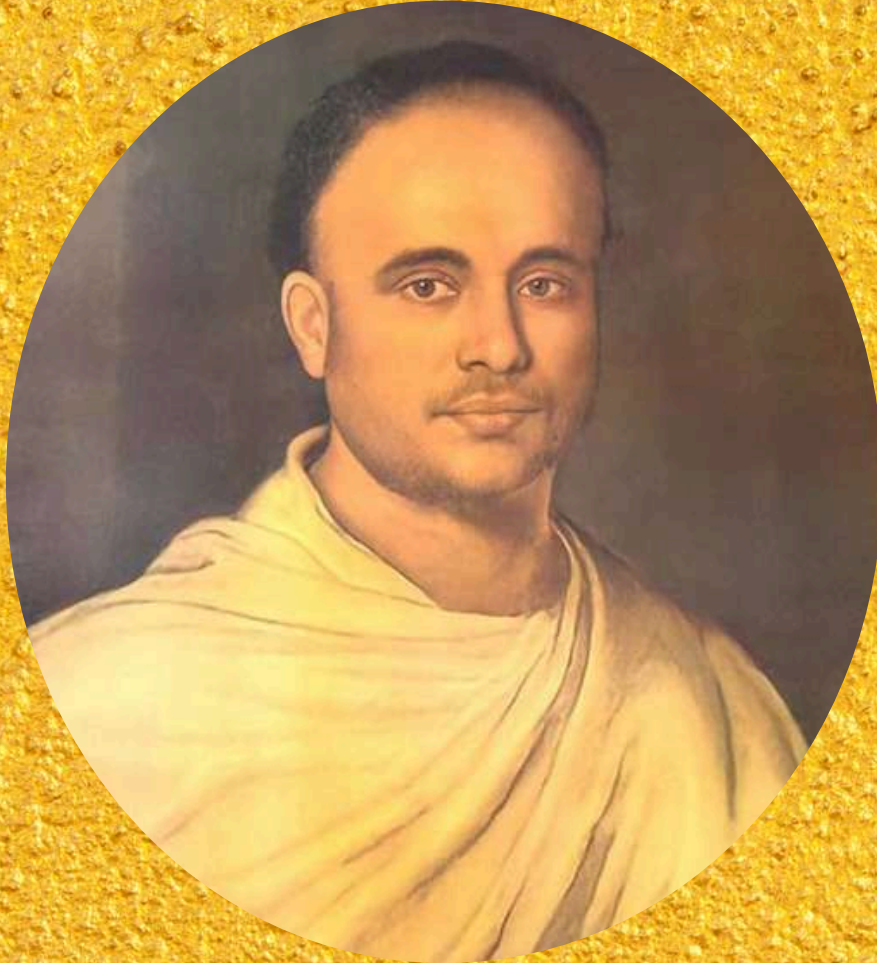

Rules and Regulations (for all departments)

- 1 Only undergraduate students from various colleges and universities can participate in the competition.**
- 2. In the singing competition, participants must sing without any musical instruments, using only their voices.**
- 3. For the PowerPoint Presentation (PPT) competition, participants must bring their slides related to the specific topic on their own pen drive, or send it to the provided email before the competition. The presentation must be delivered on the day of the competition.**
- 4. For the essay writing competition, each participant will be provided with college-branded paper and pens to write with.**
- 5. In the extempore speech competition, the main topic will be divided into subtopics, which will be chosen by lottery on the day of the competition. The selected participant will be given five minutes to speak on the assigned subtopic.**
- 6. Participants in the drawing competition must bring their own drawing materials (any medium). Only the drawing paper will be provided.**
- 7. Group participation is encouraged for the drama competition. A maximum of two teams from each educational institution can participate.**

8. For the dance performance, participants must bring a relevant song on a pen drive that matches the selected theme. Each participant will be given 3 to 4 minutes to perform.

9. For the mobile photography (online) competition, participants must submit a relevant photo taken with a mobile phone on the specified topic. The submission must be sent to vcfwcompetitions2024@gmail.com by 11 PM on 23rd September 2024, along with the participant's name, institution name, phone number, and a picture of their institution-issued ID card.

10. All participants will receive certificates of appreciation.

11. In each competition, the first, second, and third place winners will be awarded prizes. In the case of the drama competition, prizes will be given to the top three teams, as well as to the best actor.

12. Participants must register their names by 5 PM the day before the competition. Registration will be done through Google Forms, and participants will need to join a WhatsApp group created for the competition. All relevant links will be provided at the end of the rules.

13. If any participant faces difficulty in filling out the Google Form or joining the WhatsApp group, they can contact us directly via phone.

14. Participants may take part in multiple competitions, and the participant who wins the highest number of individual awards will receive a Best Participant Award.

15. There is no registration fee for participants.

16. All participants are requested to arrive 30 minutes before the competition starts.
