

Summary: An Online Session of Joint Sensitization Programme and Counselling was organized by Anti-Ragging Cell and IQAC, VCFW in Collaboration with IQAC, Rammohan College, Kolkata and IQAC, Prabhu Jagat Bandhu College, Howrah on 05.01.24 at 05:00p.m.Venue – Google Meet Platform.

The Topic of the following Session was 'How Responsible Citizens Should Raise Voice Against Ragging'. The eminent Speaker of the Topic was Smt. Chaitaly Majumdar, Psychologist and Behavioural Modifier.

The Patron of this Online Session was Dr. Sutapa Ray, Principal VCFW. Some of the notable participants present during the following Programme were – Dr. Shantanu Das, Associate Professor in Zoology, Dr. Chandrima Sen, Associate Professor in Geography, Convenor of the Anti-Ragging Cell of VCFW– Dr.Chaitali Banerjee. Members of Anti-Ragging Cell namely – Dr. Anushree Chakraborty, Dr. Joydip Ghosh, Baisakhi Roy and Dr. Sugato Gupta.

The Programme began with an inaugural note given by Dr. Chaitali Banerjee, the Convenor of Anti-Ragging Cell.

Dr. Chaitaly Majumdar started his speech with the basic concept of ragging stating the conditions prevailed during the ancient time and finally dealing with causes and consequences.

She highlighted on the cultural difference when one enters to college from school. We enjoy independence during this phase and at the same time the problem of ragging crop up to some individuals who are dragged by their seniors.

Smt. Majumdar continued her talk by focusing on the ideas – Ragging is not predominance in the same manner everywhere. Institution plays a vital role to control this situation. Any kind of mental and physical torture is called ragging. It is a punishable offence. Ragging cannot be checked only through external force. Self discipline and self control are also needed. Sensitive individual faces traumatic experience while ragging is done, sometimes leading to death or life risk.

Smt. Majumdar also gave a vital note by saying, group complain is necessary as a protest for ragging in the institution. Students' Union, College Authority, Anti-Ragging Cell in the College have a great role to play in order to stop ragging bytaking immediate action.

The Programme was very enthusiastic. Nearly fifty three (53) participants including mainly students and teachers were present in this.

The Session finally ended with a Vote of Thanks given by one of the Cell member, Dr. Anushree Chakraborty.

4. Immediately after puja holidays, the members were asked to held a meeting in the presence of External Members and update the current status of work.


5. Dr. Sugato Gupta suggested to circulate the flyer on anti-ragging along with screen recording and power-point presentation to the students through respective department.



Event 2: The hostel residents volunteered to design posters on ragging and it's various aspects. They were displayed and discussed thoroughly.


