



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

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### STATE LEVEL CONFERENCE IN COLLABORATION WITH NAAC ON "CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM: A NEW DIMENSION TO HIGHER EDUCATION"

ON AUGUST 12, 2022, AT VIDYASAGAR COLLEGE FOR WOMEN, KOLKATA

IQAC of Vidyasagar College for Women, Kolkata organised a State Level Conference on August 12, 2022 in collaboration with NAAC on a blended mode. The thrust area of the Conference was "Choice Based Credit System: A New Dimension to Higher Education."



Governing Body President of the college, Sri Vivek Gupta, MLA, acted as chief patron. Dr. Rupali Chaudhuri, Principal and Dr. Tapan Roy, IQAC Coordinator, delivered the welcome note. Dr. Pradipta Mukherjee, Convenor and Associate Professor of English of VCFW, moderated the proceedings.

The keynote was delivered by Prof. T. Ravichandran, Professor of English in the Department of Humanities and Social Sciences at the Indian Institute of Technology, Kanpur. He spoke on "National Education Policy 2020: Curriculum Implications and Challenges for CBCS syllabus Oriented Teaching." He emphasised the creation of language labs, ultra-modern virtual or smart classrooms, and use of softwares like Blackboard, MOOKIT for uploading videos and special trainings for Soft and Communication skills in all HEIs. Given the COVID 19 pandemic, Prof. Ravichandran stated that education sector demands collaborative research and critical thinking. He reiterated the focus of NEP 2020, that is to dismantle the hegemonic, colonial model and achieve a more inclusive, multidisciplinary, holistic mode of learning.

University, Pune and Sri Debasish Biswas, Inspector of Colleges, University of Calcutta acted as the other two Resource Persons. Dr. Samanta deliberated on benefits of Academic Bank of Credit, Programme and Learning outcomes, employability skills and how industry research is competing with academic research, all from a stakeholder's perspective. He stressed the importance of developing ecourses in various Indian regional languages and how the teacher should act as mentor, coach and collaborator. Sri Biswas emphasised how incorporation of NEP parameters in Higher Education, like strengthening infrastructure for online education, open learning, distance education or increased usage of technology, digital literacy, vocational exposure may be achieved through the already implemented CBCS in various Indian universities across the country.
